How to Apply for Transfer Credits

- On the [Transfer Credit Information](#) page in the Student Information section of the Economics Department website, there is a link to a google form to submit your request for transfer credits.
- Before filling out the google form, read the information posted on the Transfer Credit Information page. There are specific materials that you must include in your submission which are specified on the page. Failure to include those materials will delay the review of your request.
- Transfer credits are not reviewed on a rolling basis. They are only reviewed at the listed deadlines.

Limits on Number of Transfer Credits, AP/IB/A-levels and Barnard Electives

- Transfer credit rules are not stated in terms of credits towards the major.
- All economics majors, joint majors and financial economics majors must take a minimum of **5 lecture** courses in the Columbia Economics Department. This count does not include the senior seminar (which you must also take in the Columbia Economics Department).
- If you are plan to pursue a joint major and have courses you wish to transfer to fulfill the requirements of the other department in the joint major then you must consult that department directly.
- We do not allow students to take their intermediate core econ theory courses (UN 3211, UN 3213 and UN 3412) at Barnard. See the Economics section of the bulletin for additional restrictions on Barnard Economics Department courses.
