- 1- Study the dynamics of commodity markets, namely oil and some non-precious metals: breakdown of the sources of supply and demand (by country), Levels of inventories globally, and or among key countries, e.g., US, China, Trends in key sources of supply (US, Russia, SA, etc) and demand (US, China) and whether or not there are leads in lags (e.g., price leads US supply?)
- 2- Impact of commodity shocks on countries' fiscal and external balances: expand on the team's dataset of countries' adjustment to shocks on commodities to which they are dependent
